India's real estate market is entering a more institutional and technology-driven phase of growth. This week's developments underline the growing importance of artificial intelligence, digital infrastructure and capital markets in shaping the next cycle of expansion.

Institutional capital continues flowing into data centres and income-generating assets, while redevelopment and infrastructure upgrades create new housing supply across major cities. Simultaneously, AI is transforming everything from property discovery and investment decisions to construction and customer engagement.
